Ms. THRYKHA NIKESH came with above mentioned complaints. All baseline investigation were carried out. After getting written and informed consent she underwent the following chemotherapy with premed and throughout hydration

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Post chemotherapy she was managed with hydration through out and she had frequent blinking episodes for which magnesium correction was given , calcium added and one course of vitamin A given . She tolerated chemotherapy well. INJ. PEG-FILIGASTRIM 1.2 MG S/C STAT given on 16.09.2022. She is hemodynamically stable. Hence being discharged with necessary medical advice

3. SYP. ZOVIRAX (5 ML/400 MG) 1.5 ML P/O 1-1-1 AFTER FOOD
4. SYP. LEVIPIL 2 ML P/O 1-0-1 AFTER FOOD TO CONTINUE
5. TAB. LANZOL-JUNIOR 15 MG P/O 1-0-1 BEFORE FOOD
6. SYP. EMESET 5 ML P/O 1-1-1 BEFORE FOOD till review
7. SYP. DOMSTAL 3 ML P/O 1-0-1 BEFORE FOOD till review
8. SYP. CALCIMAX 2.5 ML P/O 1-0-1 AFTER FOOD TO CONTINUE
9. REFRESH EYE DROPS - TWO DROPS IN EACH EYE THREE TIMES A DAY
