- 3) INJ. ETOPOSIDE 56MG IN 250ML NS OVER 5 HOURS 10/10/22, 11/10/22, 12/10/22.
- 4) INJ. CARBOPLATIN 340MG IN 100ML NS OVER 1 HOUR ON 12/10/22.

Ms. Thrykha Nikesh, a 2 years old female, diagnosed with intracranial mesenchymal myxoid tumor. Right frontal craniotomy gross total excision on 25/04/22. Underwent proton therapy complete on 13/07/22. She started on ICE chemotherapy and completed 2 cycle till date. Hence been admitted for

#### Course In The Hospital & Discussion

##### Course in the Hospital:

Ms. THRYKHA NIKESH came with above mentioned complaints. All baseline investigation were carried out. After getting written and informed consent she underwent the following chemotherapy with premed and throughout hydration as follows.

- 1) INJ. IFOFAMIDE 840MG IN 100ML NS OVER 1 HOUR ON 10/10/22, 11/10/22, 12/10/22.
- 2) INJ. MESNA 250MG IV BOLUS AT 0.3,6 HOURS OF IFOFAMIDE. TO GIVE IN 20ML NS OVER 20 MINUTES AT 0.3,6 HOURS OF IFOFAMIDE 10/10/22, 11/10/22, 12/10/22.
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4) INJ. CARBOPLATIN 340MG IN 100ML NS OVER 1 HOUR ON 12/10/22.

On 11/10/2022, she had leak from PICC line site. PICC line assessed and after written consent it was changed under sedation and chemotherapy resumed.

Post chemotherapy she was managed with hydration through out. She tolerated chemotherapy well except for vomiting which was managed with anti-emetics drugs and IV fluids.

She is hemodynamically stable. Hence being discharged with necessary medical advice.

**Significant Medication Given:**

1) INJ. IFOSFAMIDE 840MG IN 100ML NS OVER 1 HOUR ON 10/10/22, 11/10/22, 12/10/22.

2) INJ. MESNA 250MG IV BOLUS AT 0.3,6 HOURS OF IFOSFAMIDE. TO GIVE IN 20ML NS OVER 20 MINUTES AT 0.3,6 HOURS OF IFOSFAMIDE 10/10/22, 11/10/22, 12/10/22.

3) INJ. ETOPOSIDE 56MG IN 250ML NS OVER 5 HOURS 10/10/22, 11/10/22, 12/10/22.

4) INJ. CARBOPLATIN 340MG IN 100ML NS OVER 1 HOUR ON 12/10/22.

INJ PEG G-CSF 1.2mg S/c given at 2.15pm (14/10/22).  
Hemodynamically stable

- SYP. EMESET 2.5 ML P/O 1-0-1 BEFORE FOOD X 3 DAYS
- SYP. BACTRIM (5 ML/40 MG) 2.5 ML P/O 1-0-1 AFTER FOOD ON SATURUDAY & SUNDAY TO CONTINUE
- SYP. ZOVIRAX (5 ML/400 MG) 1.2 ML P/O 1-1-1 AFTER FOOD TO CONTINUE
- SYP. VALPARIN 4 ML P/O 1-0-1 AFTER FOOD TO CONTINUE
- TAB. LANZOL-JUNIOR 15 MG P/O 1-0-1 BEFORE FOOD X 5 DAYS
