We have a young patient named Vedansh, a 1-year-old baby boy admitted and treated under Paediatric Medicine Common Ward. The child is diagnosed with Pneumonia and has underlying chronic lung condition in the form of Suspected Cystic Fibrosis. According to the treating team child requires further follow up. The child is on oxygen support currently. Apart from current admission baby have history of multiple times admission to our hospital due to the chronic condition.

The child's family hails from Rayachoti, Andhra Pradesh and family consists of 6 members. The primary source of income is the child's father, who is working as a driver and earns Rs. 400/day. The child's mother is a homemaker, and they also have an elder daughter who is 4 years old. The family has already spent more than two lakhs towards child's treatment, and they are financially exhausted. The patient's family is genuine and deserves support as they are from a low socio-economic background. Also, since the condition is chronic, for the management of his illness the family has to spend Rs. 10,000/- approximately every month for medications and follow up.

In view of the above, we humbly request you to kindly consider this case, support and provide the necessary financial support which will be a great support. The approximate cost of current admission is Rs. 60,000/-.
