This is to inform you that Miss Sathwika Sri Durga is 18 months female child D/O Peddiraju &. K Durgambika with UHID no: CUV-00164629 was admitted at Rainbow Children's Hospital, Vijayawada. She was diagnosed with Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia (Blood Cancer). She has been started on Chemotherapy as per ICICLE protocol. The treatment part consist of initial intensive phase for 6 months followed by maintenance phase for 2 years.

The cost of treatment in intensive phase for chemotherapy, hospitalization, investigations along with supportive care with IV antibiotic, IV anti-fungal and nutritional support is around Rs 12-14 lakhs. The cost of blood products required during entire treatment would be around Rs. 1.5-02/-lakhs. In case of any unexpected complications, cost may go up.

Child is currently in interim maintainence phase.

The cost breakup for Intensive Phase is as follows.

For the subsequent maintenance phase, cost would be around Rs. 5000 per month. As parents are financially challenged.
